I could hear giggling behind me, and I knew as the giggling grew that I was not alone. When I turned from my desk, I was greeted by the biggest brown eyes and a smile from ear to ear. Of course I had to get down on my hands and knees and greet my new friend and his big sister. They were hanging out in the boutique as their mom shopped, and I quickly found out that they had two more siblings in school. Their beautiful mother looked at me, with a smile that matched her little boy's, and said, "I am blessed with children!"

Just the week before I had met a 25 day-old, beautiful baby boy. His mom was very excited to introduce her son to all of us, and I found out later that she had begun this journey very uncertain that this was the right path for her. Now, her presence conveyed her certainty that she was called to be a mother to this little boy. I could see contentment.

And there was the woman who came to us because she had nowhere else to go. A county nurse brought her to us on a Friday, after calling one center after another that could not take her. She does not have a place to call home and she has endured much. She shared a story with our life coach that most cannot imagine, and as it unfolded she said that she was not certain

she could have this baby. By the end of her time with us, after an ultrasound provided by ICU mobile, she recognized that not having this baby would be much harder for her.

Every single day, story after story walks through our door. We are invited into very precious and intimate moments of lives, and we are humbled. Every single day, we receive these stories and hold them as sacred, because they are not ours to tell, but ours to hold for as long as we are asked. And these stories change us. We are challenged and reminded that life is about walking with someone, as they navigate their own path. This work that we are so blessed to be a part of is a great gift. You are part of the story. Through your prayers, your gifts, your time, and your generosity you serve our clients through us. Together, we honor the stories we hear each day and make a difference.

Prayer Warriors

Each day we encounter stories that challenge us, situations that are so very difficult, and a knowledge that we are just instruments in a larger plan.



We are blessed in these moments, because we recognize that this is truly not our work, but God's. Alone, we are not enough. And so we make a phone call, and ask for prayer. In that instant, our Prayer Warriors are activated. A text goes out to over 15 people, asking for immediate prayer. Maybe it is a woman that is overwhelmed and scared, just walking into our ultrasound room, maybe it is someone who does not believe there is another choice, or just maybe it is someone completely taken by surprise when they find themselves in a place they never imagined. These Prayer Warriors receive very little information, but they know that in this moment they are called to pray and that it can be a life and death situation. They rarely receive resolution about these calls, but continue this ministry, lifting our clients, their babies, and our Team in prayer, when we are not always able. These prayers are a part of the life changing work that happens at Pregnancy Choices, and the peace we feel in those moments, knowing we are covered in prayer, is beyond words.


A few years ago a young woman came to



us with an unexpected pregnancy. She was still in high school and wanted to sort out how to move forward with the difficult decisions she had to make. The young woman had shared that a vibrant pro-life group at her high school had inspired her to consider

life for her baby and she found her way to Pregnancy Choices. The group's name was Lakers for Life at Prior Lake High School.

We recently had the opportunity and privilege to speak to the Lakers for Life group and to share with them more about what we do here at our center. The experience was mutually encouraging. We gave a lively thirty-minute presentation that had the kids laughing and asking questions. The students wanted to know more about the coaching approach and where they can refer women and men who are experiencing an unexpected pregnancy. The Lakers for Life have also been generous in donating their time here at the center for the past two months helping with projects such as organizing baby bottles and addressing gala envelopes. It's been great to partner with them in our shared dedication to raising the dignity and respect of all life.





In addition to that great experience, we connected with students at Apple Valley High School recently. Last year a group of students with a passion for service began a student directed club. These young people are committed to reaching out into our local community, to serve in any way they can. Recently, they assembled "Mom's Bags" for our clients. The bags included things like: a soap bar, loofah, chap stick, a picture frame with an inspirational quote, flower seeds, candy and more. Thanks to this group's hard work we were able to gift 18 of our moms with these bags to honor them for Mother's Day, and we will continue to hand these out to our moms this month here at the center. Pregnancy Choices was invited back to Apple Valley High School the very next week to give a presentation to the students so they could learn more about life coaching and how it benefits our clients here at the center. We spent 40 minutes working through an interactive and motivating life coaching group session with 17 students. They were able to receive answers to questions they had and became more acquainted with what their neighborhood pregnancy center is doing for our community.

Perhaps most encouraging is to see that younger generations are taking our mission to heart. All of us at Pregnancy Choices are grateful to all prolife groups and other youth outreach groups like Lakers for Life and Apple Valley High School Service Club. As youth groups continue to inspire their peers to make good decisions, we continue to grow and develop innovative ways to connect to our community and are excited to help whoever comes through our door!

FEMM Chabela Ruff-Berganza

The staff at Pregnancy Choices has recently begun the integration of FEMM education. FEMM, which stands for Fertility Education and Medical Management, is a comprehensive women's health program that teaches women to understand their bodies by recognizing hormonal and other vital signs of health. Through FEMM classes, women learn how to achieve their health and reproductive goals. It is a method and education that celebrates the female person and promotes well being by using observation and awareness. Through this personal education, a woman is able to engage in meaningful conversation with a FEMM practitioner to uncover other questions about overall health. It is a practice that goes to the root cause and addresses the "why" in a question of health. As a center, we see the benefits of the program already. We started receiving clients for initial sessions the first week of May.

More local teachers and medical practitioners will be officially certifying this summer. FEMM will be available through various locations in the region. The Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis is taking action to promote what FEMM might offer as well. There in an informational meeting offered in June.
